


Number of criminal cases filed to the trial courts

Number of convicts sentenced to the deprivation of liberty is less by 1,086 individuals i.e. by 26,9 %







Share of non-custodial sentences is 57,6 %


Acquittals

Sentences passed in 6 months of 2012




Plea agreements were not approved for 21 individuals, which is 20 times more than the data of 2011




Referral to courts is increasing every year
